Self-Assessment Tool Questions

1. Are you or any member of your household experiencing any of the following?

- Severe difficulty breathing (e.g., struggling for each breath, speaking in single words)
- Severe chest pain
- Having a very hard time waking up
- Feeling confused
- lost consciousness
- Shortness of breath at rest
- Inability to lie down because of difficulty breathing
- Chronic health conditions that you are having difficulty managing because of your current respiratory illness

2. Do you have any of the following?

- Chills
- Painful swallowing
- Stuffy nose
- Headache
- Muscle or joint ache
- feeling unwell, fatigue or severe exhaustion
- Nausea, vomiting, diarrhea or unexplained loss of appetite
- Loss of sense of smell or taste
- Conjunctivitis (pink eye)

3. Have you travelled outside of Alberta in the last fourteen days?

This self-assessment tool will be posted on a stand outside the church for your convenience.

At the registration table inside the church you will be asked if you have complete the self-assessment and have answered no to all the questions.

Be sure to arrive 5 to 10 minutes early. We must lock the church doors once Mass has begun.

Bookings will be considered as ongoing unless we are told otherwise. If you will not be coming as per your booking notify the church as early as possible so we can accommodate as many walk-ins/changes as possible.

Some aspects of the Mass will be a little different for now:

- **No music or singing**
- **No handshaking during the Sign of Peace**
- **Collection basket will be setup for your contribution in a convenient place upon entry or exit**
- **Communion – you will need to wear your own non-medical mask at the time of Communion; you will stay at your place as Father will come to each pew to distribute Communion**
- **Pews and seating will be spaced to provide for physical distancing**
- **If you wish to visit with others after Mass please do so outside with physical distancing**

Father will provide directions for the first few Masses as required.
