Why was Christ transfigured on the mountain?

The Father wanted to reveal the divine glory of his Son even during Jesus' earthly life, Christ's Transfiguration was meant to help the disciples learn to understand his death and Resurrection. (Three Gospels relate how Jesus, on the mountaintop, begins to shine (is "transfigured") before the eyes of his disciples. The voice of his heavenly Father calls Jesus his "beloved Son", to whom they are supposed to listen. Peter would like to "make three booths" and capture the moment. Jesus, however is on the way that leads to suffering. The vision of glory is only to strengthen his disciples.)
